A wall poster with a baseball theme or a football theme: "Is Someone You Know Not Seeing the Whole Game?" shows the impact of the four major eye conditions on vision. Football poster is also available in Spanish.

Vision Loss: Everything You Wanted to Know but Were Afraid to Ask! (booklet)

A large-print and easy-to-read booklet designed for adults who have vision loss. It provides basic information about low vision services and devices and answers common questions about vision conditions and the importance of seeking low vision services. English and Spanish versions.

Vision Simulator Card

Allows the user to experience the impact on vision of the four most common eye diseases: cataract, glaucoma, macular degeneration and diabetic retinopathy. English/Spanish.

Functional Screening for Vision Loss (Card)

A pocket-sized card with questions to screen a person for vision problems that could indicate the need for low vision rehabilitation. Versions available for vision care providers, other health professionals, and nursing home staff. English/Spanish.

Guide Techniques (DVD and Booklet)

A 10-minute video and full-color, 20-page booklet that provide detailed instruction of the guide technique, an effective method to assist a person with vision loss, and other common self-travel techniques. Valuable for anyone who works with, cares for, or interacts with a person with vision loss. English and Spanish versions.

Assisting People with Vision Loss (Instructional Brochure)

This brochure provides useful and effective tips for sighted people on how to improve personal interactions with people with vision loss. It can be used in conjunction with a training program or as an independent instructional resource.

Signature Guide / Reading Guide

A card that can be used to help people sign their name while staying on the line, and also used when reading to maintain the correct line and reduce the detrimental effects of glare. English/Spanish.

Caring for People with Vision Loss (Reference Manual)

This 57-page manual describes and illustrates common vision conditions, the impact of vision loss, orientation and mobility techniques, environmental considerations, and ways to promote independence for people with vision loss in activities of daily living.

Caring for People with Vision Loss at Home (DVD)

This 25-minute video is designed for people who provide direct care services. It shows many important aspects of caring for people with vision loss at home. In the four parts of the video, the viewer will see the correct way to assist people with vision loss in basic daily activities such as transferring, eating, dressing and bathing.

Tips for Assisting People with Vision Impairment: Activities of Daily Living (Full-sized pamphlet)

This full-color pamphlet provides tips for assisting a person with vision loss in transferring, eating, dressing, and bathing. It is a valuable instructional tool for those providing care in various settings.
